The smoke was creating burning eyes, sore throats and breathing problems in some of our students and staff. On our second day indoors, it was like we were still outside. The air filters could not handle the amount of pollutants in the air and as a result all the rooms on campus smelt of smoke. This made me start to think about all the times the Lord filled the Tabernacle with the cloud of His presence.

1 Kings 8:10-11, "And when the priests came out of the Holy Place, a cloud filled the house of the LORD, so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD."

The presence of the Lord is so powerful it permeates everything around us. Even though we could not see smoke in our buildings, its presence was definitely felt and smelt. Even when we may not sense the presence of the Lord in our midst, He is indeed in our midst at all times.

The presence of the Lord can stop us in our tracks. 1 Kings 8 tells us that the priests could not physically stand to minister. God's presence was so powerful that the priests lost even the strength to stay on their feet.

The presence of the Lord changes our view of things. I drove to Mendocino County on Labor Day weekend to visit with my family. I was hoping to drive out of the smoke, but low and behold I was greeted with smoke from the Helena fire. Driving home on Labor Day the smoke was so thick in both Lake and Mendocino Counties that you could not see any of the mountains. I knew they were there, but they were unseen, even Mt. Konocti!

2 Corinthians 4:18 says, "as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal." My prayer is that Oroville Christian School will strive to impart the truths regarding the presence of the Lord. That our students will know without a shadow of a doubt that His presence is there with them even though they may not see or feel Him at all times.
