## Courage

Courage, the mere saying of the word can bring a myriad of thoughts, feeling and emotions. Sometimes we wake up feeling courageous and ready to take on the world. Other days, we may feel frightened, cowardly, and just ready stay in bed.

The definition of courage we are learning this month is “Overcoming fear so I can do what is right”. A courageous person “takes heart” when things look hopeless. Instead of shrinking back when you are afraid, **courage means overcoming your fear so you can do what is right.**

One year I took my Children's Ministry group to a water park. It had a slow “river” to lazily float on. That was my plan for the day, BUT that's not what my students had in mind. Of course, they wanted me to go down all the waterslides. I hemmed and hawed to no avail and finally I knew I was going to have to attempt at least a few of the slides. I started with the shortest and worked my way up. I remember feeling so nervous as I climbed the stairs up and up. When I finally reached the top, I had to continue the commitment by sitting down and riding that slide all the way to the bottom. I must say it was fun once I was going, but the journey to the top was terrifying for me. The thing that helped me the most was knowing I was not alone. Many of my students accompanied me to the top of the slides. They cheered me on and comforted me when I wanted to chicken out! Jesus was with me too! I knew He would give me the courage to overcome my fear!

### Courage requires confidence!

- Always do your best. When you stumble and fall, pick yourself up and keep going.
- Surround yourself with friends who will encourage you in the right direction.
