Could you imagine your child going to school and not having any books? Each child must hand copy their own books from what the teacher prints on the black board each day. Students sit 4-5 to a bench that is designed to really sit 2 students. These young people are eager to learn and hunger for God's Word. With the offerings we collect we can help meet the needs of these children and teachers.

Every Friday after chapel, there are some items for sale (next to Room 15 in the chapel). They are items made in Uganda by parents of the students. All the funds will go to help this mission school and for outreach to the community to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

OCS students may, with parents and teacher's permission go and purchase these items following chapel. There are "suggested donation" prices, but it's always nice when families can be extra generous for this opportunity to encourage the Christian school and missionaries.

Miss Tammie asks that we pray for God to work in Lagazi, Uganda. She asks we pray not only for the school, but for Jesus Christ to be known and that the people turn to Him as their Lord and Savior.

We can do that can't we? With all that we have, can't we give our hearts in prayer? Yes, I know we can!

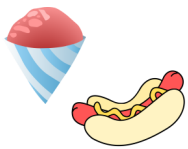
