What does a Biblical Worldview look like for an OCS graduate?

Preparing students for life by helping them to “develop a sound biblical worldview.” This is a part of the Mission of OCS. How do we do we teach this at OCS?

By teaching them the Biblical Teachings in all the categories that make a Worldview, going through the following using the lens of Scripture:

Theology: The study of the existence, nature and attributes of God. What about God?

Philosophy: The attempt to discover an explanation for the whole of existence or reality. What's real?

Biology: The study of the origin and development of living organisms. What about life?

Psychology: The study of the soul, mind, and spirit. What about human nature?

Ethics: The study of what is right and wrong behavior. What's right?

Sociology: The study of social institutions and society. What about Society?

Law: The study of basic principles of nature and human conduct that are expected to be observed. Who makes the rules?

Politics: The art of governing a city, state, or nation. What about government?

Economics: The management of resources, whether by an individual or a society. What about money?

History: The study of past places, persons and events and how they influence the present and future. What about the past?

This is the goal of our instruction in our classes from pre-school through 8th grade, and I thank God for the teachers who are helping us prepare students for their future stations in life.
