What is Love as Defined by the Bible?

Everybody seems to believe that love is a good thing. However, not all agree what is love. Is love that warm touchy-feely feeling a person has when he is with a familiar person? According to the Bible, love is actions and attitudes. Love isn't what we feel, but what we do.

The Bible indicates that love is from God. In fact, the Bible says "God is love." Love is one of the primary characteristics of God. Likewise, God has endowed us with the capacity for love, since this capacity for love is one of the ways in which we are "created in the image of God."

"For God so loved (agape) the world", that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. (John 3:16)

In contrast, our love is usually conditional and based upon how other people behave toward us. This kind of love is based upon familiarity and direct interaction. The Greek word "phileo" defines this kind of love, often translated "brotherly love" it is emotionally driven.

The most famous biblical chapter on love is from 1 Corinthians Chapter 13:1-13

Love is: as you read these characteristics place your name in and say, "I am patient, I am kind" and so forth. As you do this ask yourself and I truly being in my actions and attitudes a loving person in these areas towards others?

"YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND." Matthew 22:37 He then added that the second most important law was "YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF." Jesus said that the entire law was dependent upon these two commandments, but one principle "Love your neighbor as more important than yourself.

When we can look out for others interests as more important than our own, we are truly loving as Jesus would want us to. (Philippians 2:1-5).

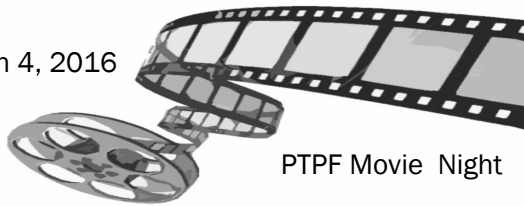

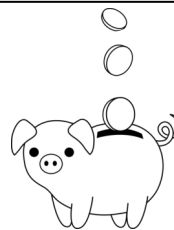
